Dear Parents/Guardians and Returning Students,

The Home and School Committee invites all returning students, (who know how to read), to join our Summer Reading Club. The purpose of the Reading Club is to encourage students to continue reading over the summer holidays.

Completion of the program will be rewarded with an Achievement Certificate, presented at the Awards Assembly. (Three certificates will earn a BAR, and 5 BARS earn a letter, JKCS). As well, students who read the required amount of books/pages for their grade will earn a BAR. The requirements are:

Category 1:

JK-Grade 1 10 books = Achievement Certificate 50 books (1000) = BAR

Category 2:

Grade 2 & 3 8 books = Achievement Certificate 50 books (2,500pages) = BAR

Category 3:

Grade 4 & 5 8 books = Achievement Certificate 50 books (5,000pages) = BAR

Category 4:

Grade 6-8 8 books = Achievement Certificate 50 books (6,500 pages) = BAR

All books must be at your current reading level.

The Home and School Committee will also present the “**top**” reader in each Category with an additional prize!

Please use the form on the back of this sheet to record the name and author of the book read and the number of pages that each book contains. A parent/guardian signature is then required after each book completed. If you require additional copies of the tracking sheet, they can be downloaded from the JKCS website at: www.jkcs-oakville.org under School Forms.

Each participant is to bring back their form during the first week of school in September, and place it in the SUMMER READING PROGRAM DROP BOX located in the Lobby.

Thank you for supporting your child’s continual growth in reading. We look forward to seeing you all and following up with our Club Participants in September 2006. Have a wonderful summer!
